

Resolutions on Asia-Pacific Meeting of WPC Held in Kathmandu on June 12-13, 2009

On Religious Fundamental & Terrorism in South Asia

Through the passing of nearly two decades time, word 'fundamentalism' has transformed into 'religious fundamental terrorism'. This phenomenon was created by US imperialism to combat progressive forces in Afghanistan, creating Taliban and Al-Qaeda in association with American allies. The meeting demands for an immediate halt of the drone attacks in areas of Pakistan boarder territory.

- demands for immediate deployment of peace keeping forces in Afghanistan to secure the civilians and rebuild Afghanistan.

- demands for inquiry commissions of the killing of innocent people and destroying public facilities and stopping girls from education and restricting civil liberties in Afghanistan and Pakistan.
